BREASTFEEDING POLICY

Throughout this policy references to 'Playgroup' includes Kineton Playgroup, KASC and Breakfast Club.

Aim

Kineton Playgroup supports mothers and their wish or need to breastfeed young children whilst on the premises. The main purpose of this policy is to ensure they can achieve this in an environment where they feel comfortable. A further aim is to promote a positive image of breastfeeding amongst all children attending playgroup.

Policy

Mothers visiting playgroup, or volunteering for playgroup sessions, who wish to breastfeed young children during their visit may do so wherever they feel comfortable to do so. If they feel they would like a little more privacy, they should speak with the session supervisor and may use the staff room.

Appropriate provision will also be made for any mothers, including members of staff, who wish to express and store breast milk while at playgroup.
